

- As blooms fade on perennials, trim plants, and fertilize to gain and stimulate new growth for a spectacular fall show of blooms


#### WINE-O GROUP (WOG)

# CITY OF DALLAS

LFH Construction along Old Gate has caused quite a stir lately! Over the past months, Atmos has been busy with utility work along Old Gate and the surrounding alleys from Garland Road to Santa Clara. Unfortunately, their efforts have left much to be desired, with temporary patches on sidewalks, streets, and alleys deteriorating, especially with the recent rains. However, the City of Dallas, Dept. of Public Works has assured us that the contractor will be addressing these issues in the coming weeks to restore everything to its original condition.

In other news, the upcoming Dallas Bond Program election on May 4th holds significant importance for LFH, particularly regarding funding for the future White Rock Hill Recreation Center on Highland Rd. Remember to cast your vote and have your say in shaping our community's future! For more information, visit:

Additionally, the city, in collaboration with TXDoT, has installed temporary white plastic water-filled barriers along Garland Road at the lake to safeguard the trail. Rest assured, plans are underway for a more aesthetically pleasing long-term solution—a low wall that harmonizes with other lake structures, potentially mirroring the entry at East Lawther Drive.





Little Forest Hills started taking shape on the heels of the completion of White Rock Lake in 1910, but it truly came into its own during the bustling 1930s. Amidst the backdrop of that era, what emerged were not just homes, but a testament to a different way of life.

These wood-framed abodes, constructed in the 1930s and 40s, weren't just houses; they were the embodiment of a bygone era's leisure and adventure. Originally serving as recreational lake houses and hunting cabins, they bore witness to a time when this area was considered the outskirts of Dallas. In fact, many original homes still remain in Little Forest Hills today.
